These audits are also the first step required if you are looking to take advantage of the energy efficiency loans they offer to homeowners. Below are a few of the items they offer loans on:

- Ductwork
- Electric Vehicle Home Charging Stations
- Energy Star Appliances
- Solar Films
- Stand-by Generators

TIPS FOR THE 2022 HURRICANE SEASON June 1st – November 30th

<u>Understand the difference</u>:

- Watch: Conditions are possible in the area.
 - o Hurricane watches are issued 48 hours prior to the onset of any possible anticipated tropical storm force winds.
- Warning: Conditions are expected in the area.
 - o Hurricane warnings are issued 36 hours prior to anticipated tropical storm force winds.

<u>Build a disaster kit</u>: bottled water, non-perishable snacks, flashlights, batteries, sanitation items, important documents and a first aid kit. For families with young children a kit may include pens, paper, crayons, coloring books or a sketch pad to keep them busy, calming items such as blankets, a favorite stuffed animal or their favorite book.

<u>Clear the debri</u>: it is recommended residents keep drains, gutters and yards clear of debris.
